Through our free mentorship programs in person, online, and on demand, girls experience more than just mentorship. They find community, feel empowered to expand their horizons, and develop the skills they need to navigate life's path with confidence.

By the end of 2025, we've committed to reach 3,000 teens and young women annually through programs that guide girls to be confident, connected and career-ready.


